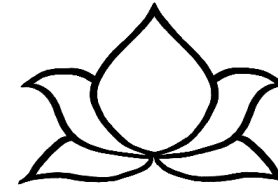

About Intermediate Junior Assessments and Certificates

The Intermediate Junior certificate is graded into three levels. Candidates for Level I must have held the introductory certificate and the Certification Mark for at least 18 months. A minimum of six months must pass before taking the next Intermediate Junior Level assessment. Only holders of Junior Intermediate certificate Level II and higher may conduct therapeutic yoga classes.

Assessments are organised by the IYA(UK) and usually take place each year in March. Applications for assessment should be made to IYA(UK) by 30 September the previous year. Candidates are assessed on both their practice and their teaching and there are also detailed written papers at each level.

About Richard Agar Ward

Richard is a senior pupil of Sri BKS Iyengar. He has been practising Iyengar Yoga since 1975 and teaching for over 30 years. He has attended classes at RIMYI in Pune on 17 visits and is qualified to teach at Senior Intermediate level 3. He is a Moderator for the IYA(UK).

Richard is an approved teacher trainer and began training Introductory level Iyengar Yoga teachers in 1990. He has conducted Intermediate Junior teacher training at IYI Maida Vale, London since 1996. He also conducts Intermediate Senior teacher training in Bath.

About Bath Iyengar Yoga Centre

We have a fully equipped yoga studio in a quiet riverside location in the heart of Bath, We are just a few minutes walk from the mainline railway and bus stations. Bath is also easily accessible by car and there are car parks and street parking nearby. There is no need to bring any equipment. Each session includes a half hour break.

Requirements of BIYC Trainees

Intermediate Junior Iyengar Yoga teacher training is a big commitment. As well as attending the entire training course you will be expected to:

- attend a weekly intermediate level Iyengar Yoga class (preferably more)
- attend other Iyengar yoga workshops, conventions and yoga days
- practise daily on your own for 1-2 hours, Iyengar method only
- read recommended texts
- complete on time any assignments between training sessions

Failure to observe any of these requirements satisfactorily may lead to your not being put forward for assessment or even to your being asked to leave the course. Fees will not be refunded in this case.



Fees Training course 2010 – 2011:

By instalment:

1st instalment: £120.00 for Mar, Apr, May. Payable on application or by 1 March at latest.

2nd instalment: £120.00 for June, July, Sept. Payable by 1 June.

3rd instalment: £120.00 for Oct, Nov, Feb. Payable by 1 October

Payment by cheque (payable to "Bath Iyengar Yoga Centre"), cash or BACS

Pay as you go: £46.00 per class (advance notification required & subject to place availability). Payment by cash or cheque.

Please note:

- You need to have had at least one year's teaching experience at Introductory level II and to be a teacher member of IYAUUK to apply for this course.
- Places are limited. You are advised to apply early to ensure a place.
- You must advise us of any medical conditions or injuries before booking (or before the class if they occur after booking).
- Booking fees are non-refundable.
- You will be informed of whether or not you have a place within 2 weeks of receipt of your application.
